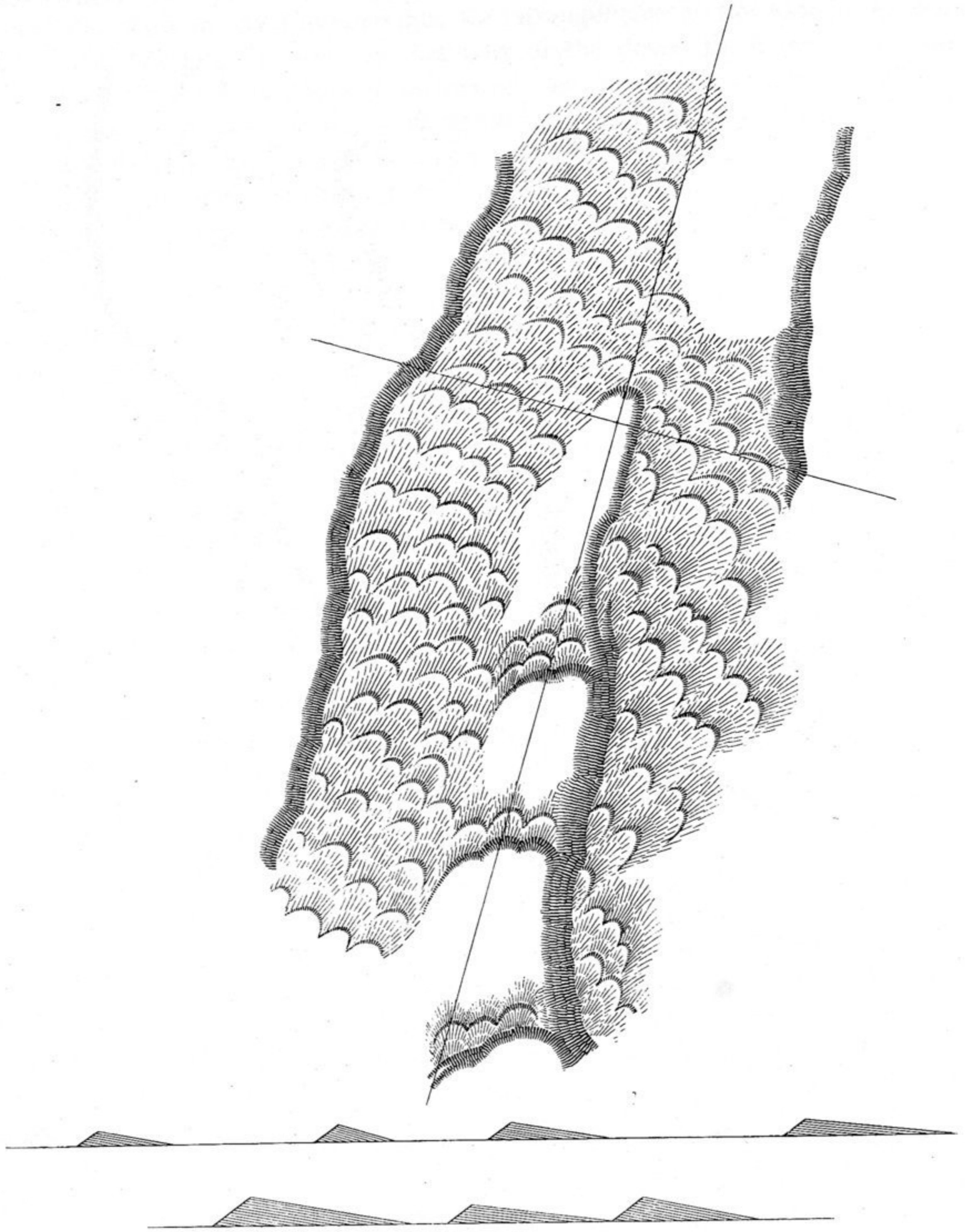


Fig. 318. SKETCH OF BAJIRS NO. 15, 16, 17, 18 AND PART OF 19. VERTICAL SECTIONS FROM
