

·D'ai-lji : native meaning of Ta-li for the name of the city of the 8th cent. and for the dynastic name of 938.

 ·D'ai-liei : native meaning of Ta-li for the dynastic name of c. 860.  
 See CARAGIAN, p. 176.  
 Dū-'l-faḡār : Ar., vulg. Zulfiqār, « Master of the Vertebrae »; this

is « Çulficar ».  
 See ÇULFICAR, p. 610.  
 Dū-'l-Qarnain : Ar., « Master of the Two Horns » an epithet of Alexander the Great.  
 See ÇULCARNEIN, p. 610.  
 Δεγγιζιχ : the name of Attila's son is hard to explain with Turk. *tāngiz*, « sea ».

« Aibat-al-maḡal » : in Ibn-Battūṭah, the Maldives.

 ḡū-'l-qa'dah : (20th, A.H.549 = January 26, 1155) cannot be retained as the date of Chingiz-khan's birth.
