

D'ai-lij : native meaning of Ta-li for the name of the city of the 8th cent. and for the dynastic name of 938.

D'ai-liei : native meaning of Ta-li for the dynastic name of c. 860.

Dū'l-faqār : Ar., vulg. Zulfiqār, « Master of the Vertebrae »; this

is « Culficar ».

Dū'l-Qarnain : Ar., « Master of the Two Horns » an epithet of Alexander the Great.

Δεγγιζίχ : the name of Attila's son is hard to explain with Turk. tāngiz, « sea ».
