

**Fu-tu** : reading proposed for the first characters of the names of most of the successors of Yü-ch'ih Ch'ü-mi; it cannot be retained.

*fu-tu* : « second capital ».

« **Fu-tu** » : the second character has two pronunciations, *tu* (\**tu*) and *shê* (\**d'z'ia*); it is always *shê* in transcriptions.

*fu-t'ai* : colloquial title of the Ch'ing provincial governors.

**Fu-t'o** : (\**B'juk-d'a*) it would be arbitrary to identify with *boydo* this T'o-pa Wei name.

**Fu-t'u** : (\**B'juk-d'uo*) it is arbitrary to connect *boydo* with this Juan-juan name.

**Fu-t'u** : *t'u* is a clerical error for *shê*.

*Fu-yung* : a technical term used in ancient China in reference to small feudal states, and used later in reference to nations of Central Asia.

### FUGIU.

This is of course Fu-chou.

Three forms of the name occur on the Catalan Map : « Fogo » - « Fuguj » and « Fugu ». Odoric writes « Fuço ». Fra Mauro gives « Fuguy ».

« **Fugiu** » : « Choncha » was probably corrupt for it.

\**fuγ* (*fūγ*) : Sogdian, has passed in later Sogdian from the sense of « god » to that of « idol ».

**Fuju** : it is Rašid's transcription of Fu-chou, outside the Great Wall.

*fulūri* : « florin »; name of the golden coin in use at Aden.

*funduq* : (Pers.) « filbert ».

*funduq* and *fīndīq* : (Turk.) « filbert ».

*funduqlt* or *fīndīqlt* : gold coins (?), in Osmanli Turks, (in *El*).

« **Fungul** » : corruption of « Cuigiu ». See CURMOS, p. 576.

« **Fur** » : a mistake in the Milan copy.

« **Fusi** » : misreading by Zurla and Hallberg of Fra Mauro's « susi ». See DRY (LONE) TREE, p. 635.

**Fuzui** : mentioned by Zurla. May perhaps be read « Suçui » or even « Suçiu », it is Su-chou.

**Fūjū** : name given by Rašidu-d-Dīn to Fu-chou. He describes it as the seventh *šing*.

*fūlād* : in Arab. means eastern steel.

*fūlāt* : in Şundur-fūlāt, can be explained with Mal. *pulau*.

*fūāng* : (1/8 of a tical) there were 800 cowries to it in Siam from the 17th to the first half of the 19th cent.

φάρφουρι : Greek form from *farfurī*, Pers. > *farfuru*, *farfuri* Turk.
