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- * *ša-lā* : *sha-lo*, an alternative form of *so-lo* without authority. See COTTON, p. 468.
- * *Ša-lāk-ka* : *Sha-lo-chja*, a convent of the kingdom of Kapiši. See CASCAR, p. 200.
- * *Ša-lək* : *Sha-lo*, a Chinese transcription of *Kāšyar*. See CASCAR, p. 197.
- Šanf* : early Arabic transcription, represents a pronunciation *Čampa*. See CIAMBA, p. 255.
- * *šāla* : (* *šāla*) this is the form supposed by *sha-lo* (* *ša-lā*). See COTTON, p. 468.
- * *Šarakavati* : for * *Šaraka*, is not plausible. See CASCAR, p. 200.
- * *Ši'o-lək* : *Shu-lo*, the first Chinese mention of *Kāšyar*. See CASCAR, p. 196.
- šūf al-baħr* : « wool of the sea », occurs in mediaeval Arabic authors. See COTTON, p. 509.
- Šundur* : explained as the outcome of *Kundur* > *K'undur* > *Čundur* > *Šundur*.

- See CONDUR, p. 406.
- Šundur* : this is evidently represented by Polo's « *Sondur* ». Polo heard both names, this one and *Kundur*. See CONDUR, p. 407.
- Šundur* : there might be some connection between this name and that of *Kundur*. See CONDUR, p. 407.
- Šundur-fülāt* : this must be « *Sondur* » in the early Arabic narratives. See CONDUR, p. 406.
- Šundur-fülāt* : it is not *Pulo Condor*, and it is not *Hai-nan*; it is probably *Culao Cham*. See CONDUR, p. 406.
- Šundur-pūläu* : *Šundur-fülāt* has been explained as a Persian plural of this arabized form. See CONDUR, p. 406.
- σηρικόν* : name of products of * *Θiv?*, mentioned in the *Periplus*. See CIN, p. 266.
- σῆρ* : given by *Pausanias* as the Greek name of the silkworm, different from the Chinese name;

- occurs only in the 2nd cent. A. D. See CIN, p. 265.
- σηρικόν* : hardly to be separated from « *Sēres* »; but it does not seem certain that its use is not here due to *Strabo* himself. See CIN, p. 264.
- Σῆρες* : name under which classical antiquity knew *China* and the *Chinese*. See CIN, p. 264.
- Σηρικα* : « silk textiles », are said to be mentioned at the end of the 4th cent. B.C. by *Nearchus* (in *Strabo*); is does not seem certain that the use of *σηρικόν* is not here due to *Strabo* himself. See CIN, p. 264-265.
- Σηρική* : *Ptolemy* speaks of the *Σίβαι* and of their sea-port *Καττίγαρα* as being south of it. See CIN, p. 267.
- Σίβαι* : mentioned by *Ptolemy*. See CIN, p. 267.
- Σχίνη* : in *Vettius Valens*, may refer to *China*. See CIN, p. 267.
