

**ükärči** : modern Mongol word for a cowherd, derived from *ükär*, « ox »; the mediaeval form is *hügäci, hükäcin*.  
 See CINGHIS, p. 290.

**Üldü** (\*Bäktüt's father) : the Tatar who stayed with him in Eastern Persia must have been near cousins to the Qaraunas.  
 See CARAUNAS, p. 189.

**ünän kä'ür** : (*Altan tobči*) Chinghizkhan's « true corpse », buried at Burqan-qaldana or at the *Yäkä-undui*.  
 See CINGHIS, p. 345.

**ürä** : « descendant » (*Altan tobči*).  
 See CINGHIS, p. 351.

**Ürgänj** : the queen « Organa » always connected by commentators with Rubrouck's « Organum ». *Organinus* would be a regular derivative form of *Organum*.  
 See ERCOLIN, p. 646.

\***Ürüngä** : according to Rašid, *Arıq-bögä* used to spend the winter there.  
 See CINGHIS, p. 342.

**Ürünggü** : (*Secret History*), Rašid's \**Ürüngä*.  
 See CINGHIS, p. 342.

**üsük** : occurs for mare's milk in « Sanang Setsen ».  
 See CHEMIS, p. 240.

**Ütükan** : See *Ötökän*.  
 See NATIGAI, p. 791.

**Üzbäg-khan** : this khan of the Golden Horde ordered the execution of the Russian Grand-Duke Michael in 1319.  
 See MENGIAR, p. 777.

**ὄλη** : Greek for « matter » according to Erdmann, *Hülün* is « surely » a rendering of it.  
 See DARKNESS (PROVINCE OF), p. 618.

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
