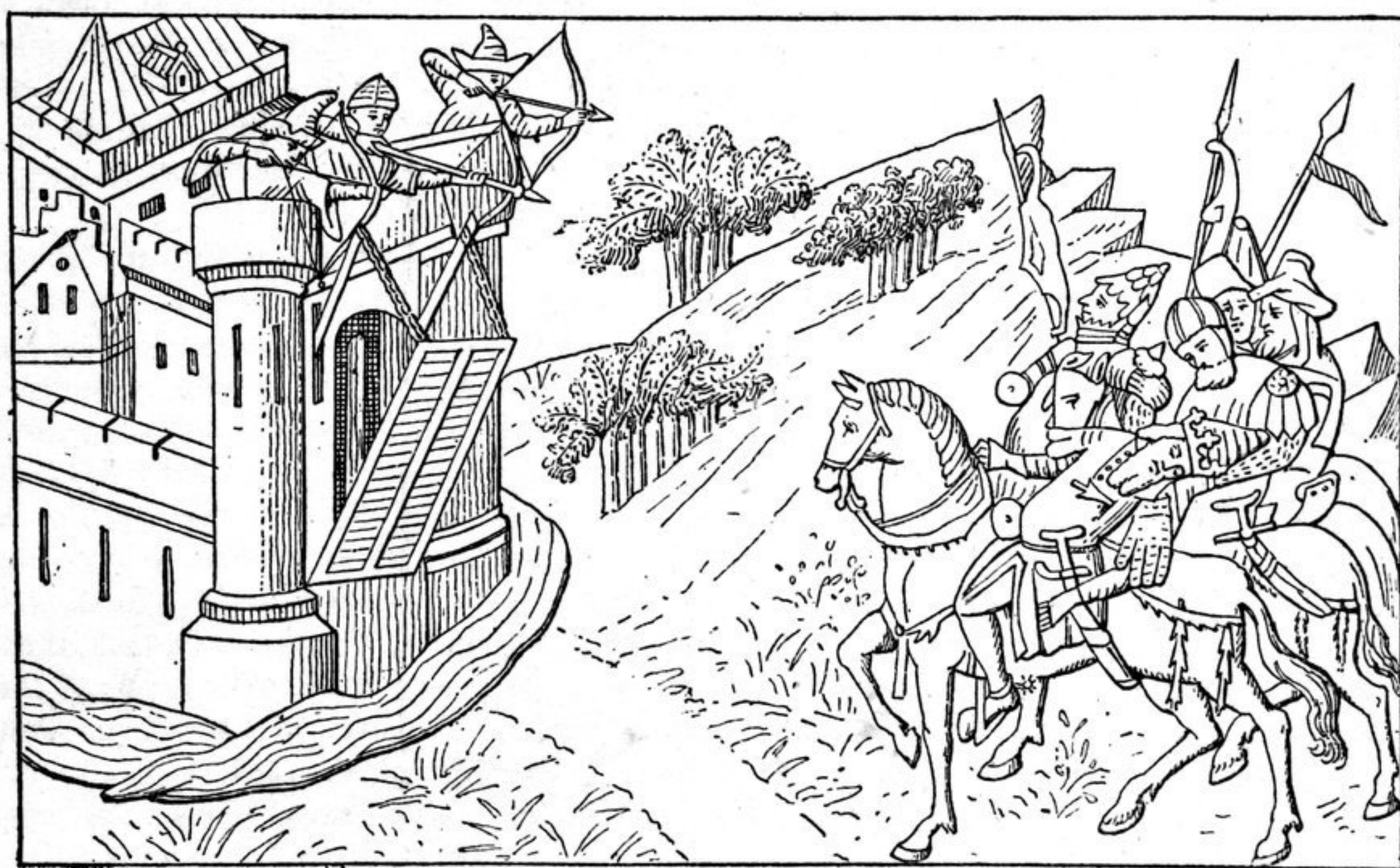


CHAPTER L.
