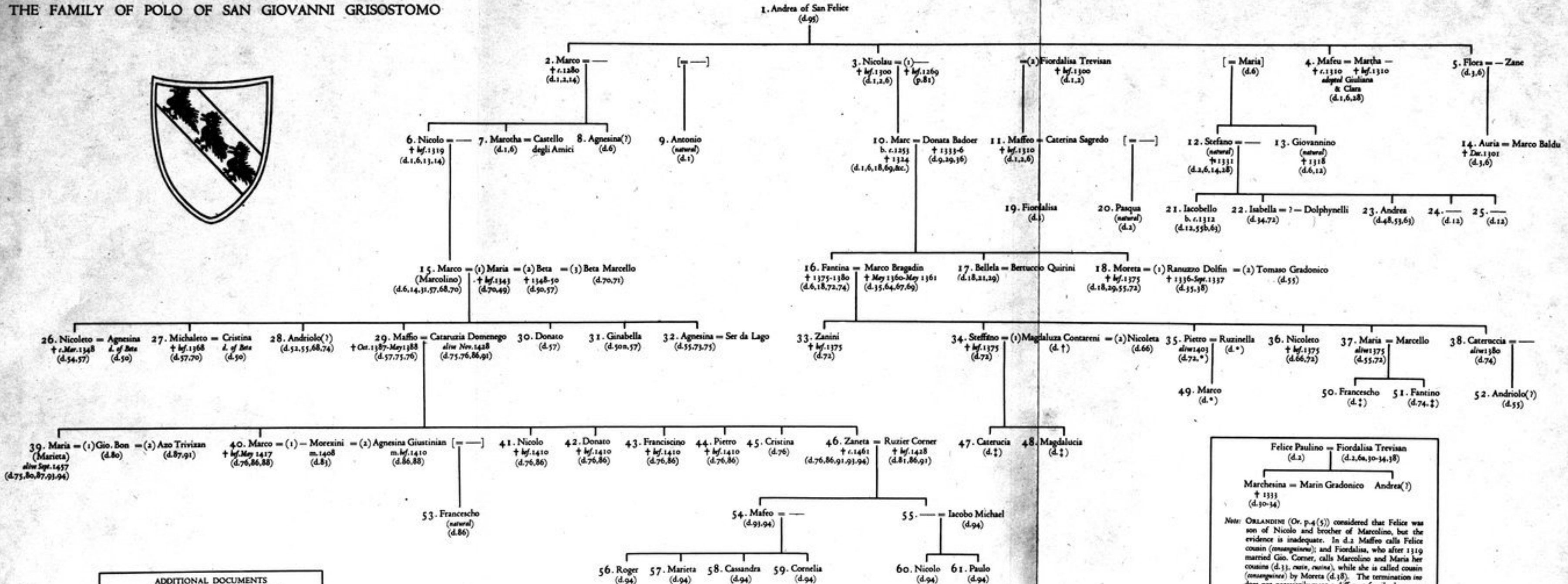

Felice Paulino = Fiordalisa Trevisan (d.2) (d.2.6a.30-34.38)
 Marchesina = Marin Gradonico † 1133 (d.30-34) † Andrea(?)
 Note: ORLANDINI (Or. p. 4 (5)) considered that Felice was son of Nicolo and brother of Marcolino, but the evidence is inadequate. In d. 2 Maffeo calls Felice cousin (consanguineo); and Fiordalisa, who after 1119 married Gio. Corner, calls Marcolino and Maria her cousins (d. 11. cons. consue), while she is called cousin (consanguineo) by Moreta (d. 18). The termination in does not necessarily mean a different family, but may have been used by some members of the family for the sake of distinction, just as Marco (15) was called Marcolino to distinguish him from his famous cousin. cf. d. 14.
