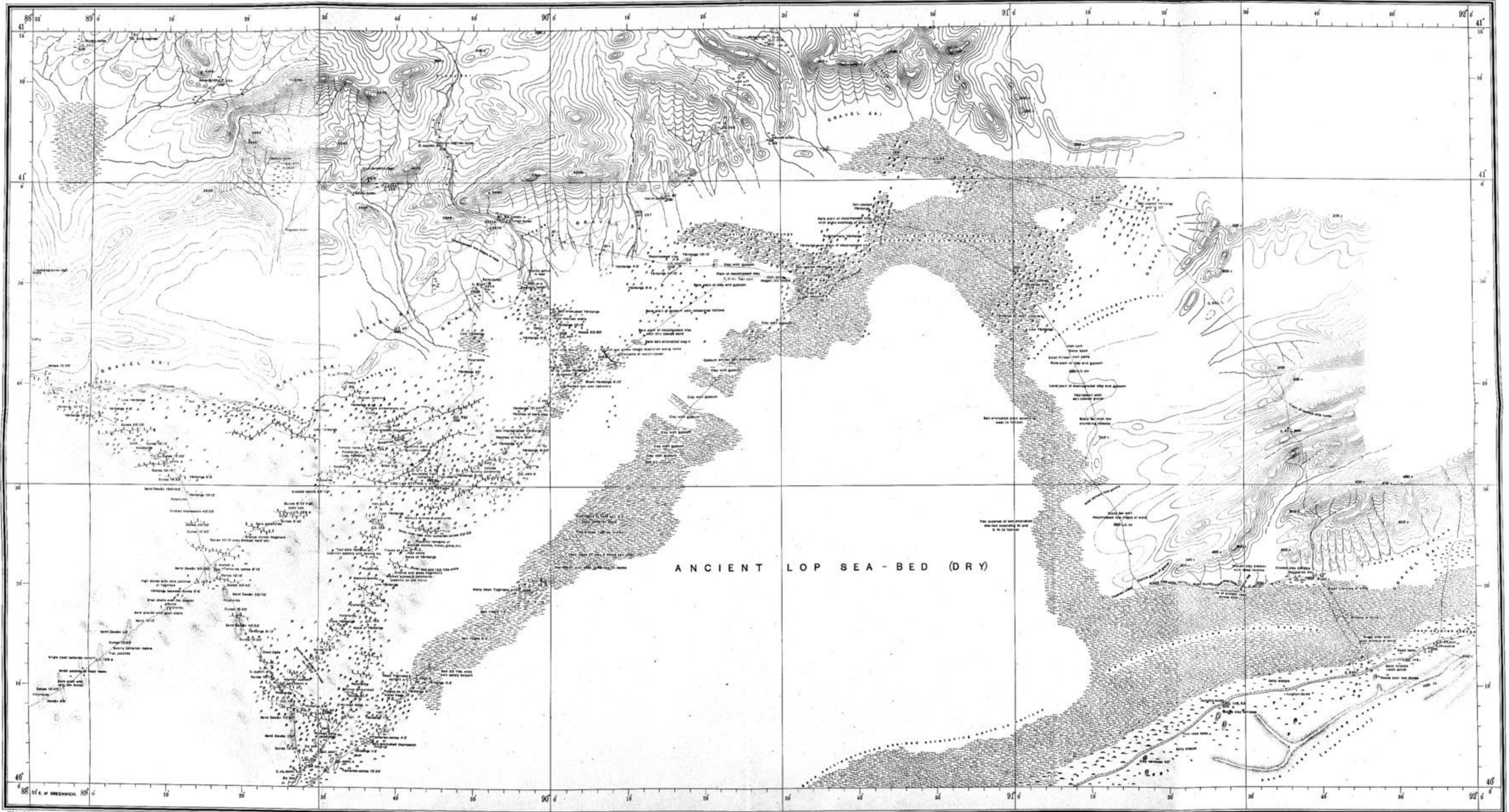


MAP OF THE LOP DESERT
