Northern Tibet, Camp VII, Temirlik, 2961 m., 10th July 1900 (young flower-buds only); Kash-otak, 2916 m., medio Aug. 1900 (flow.).

Northern Tibet, Sarik-kol, Kwen-lun, 3469 m., 5th Aug. 1896; Camp XVII, 5073 m., 1st Sept. 1896; Camp XXXI, 4616 m., 21st Sept. 1896.

The identification of the two first nos. is not sure, as there are no flowers present.
