

Eastern *Pamir*, Kamper-kishlak, Mus-tagh-ata, ab. 4500 m., 29th July 1894 (flowering).

Geogr. area: Transbaicalia, Mongolia, Altai, Songaria.

***Pedicularis* spp.**

East-*Turkestan*, Chigelik-ui, Lower Tarim, 819 m., 11th—18th June 1900 (with young inflorescence).

Eastern *Tibet*, Near Camp XLIV, 5127 m., 18th Aug. 1901 (flowering, but later spoiled by insects).

S. W. *Tibet*, Between Camp CXCIV, Gjangtju-kaman, 4661 m., and Camp CXCIV, Thärck, 4657 m., valley of Upper Tsangpo, 6th July 1907.

(A little doubtful. The specimens are very young and hardly flowering).

Geogr. area: Himalaya.

Fam. Solanaceæ

East-*Turkestan*. »Occurs everywhere at Tarim and Lop-nor. The east-turkish name of this plant, Ak-tikken (*i. e.* white t.) is very common in geographical names. I have passed 9 places called Tikkenlik« (Sven Hedin on the schedule). Ab. 850 m. Spring or early summer of 1900 (sterile).

Geogr. area: Southern Russia, S. W. Siberia, Transcaspia, Songaria.

Northern *Tibet*, Between Camp XXIX and XXX, 4863 m., 20th Sept. 1896 (det. Hemsley and Pearson).
