## REPORT ON THE ARTUSH (LOWER) BAZAAR MADE IN FEBRUARY 1874.

*En route* to Artush we passed Besh Kirrim, a considerable group of hamlets in the Kashghar district comprising 960 houses; this is one of the principal fruit-growing portions of the Kashghar district.

Besh Kirrim has a small bazaar of its own on Wednesdays.

From Besh Kirrim the road, which leads from the city to Lower Artush, runs through a small gap to the Artush valley on the other side of a low sand ridge: in the gorge is a small shrine to Sút Bium, the wet-nurse of Sultan Satúk Bogra Khan; the first hamlet in the Artush valley termed Lungur is 8 miles from Besh Kirrim; the road from this passes at 6 miles through the hamlet of Beh Ahmed at one mile from Artush proper.

In the entire district of Artush are some 2,000 houses, which are grouped in hamlets as follows:—
