Beg, Important native official Caravan Bashi, Head of a Caravan Chang Tang, Native name for Tibet Chow Kuan, District Magistrate Cho, Lake Dawan, Pass Ghi or Ghee, Butter, (often rancid) Kara, Black Kyang, Wild Donkey Kuk Bashi, Head of Canals Kul, Lake La, Pass Marpa, Small one-horse Chinese cart Ming Bashi, Head of 1,000 Oan Bashi, Head of 10 Sai, Water Sheetai, Chief military officer, corresponding to General Officer Commanding Sin Chiang, Chinese name for Chinese Turkestan Suttoo, parched barley, ground, (in which there is often plenty of dirt) Su, Water Taotai, Chief civil officer Teetai, Chief military officer Yak dan, Indian-made leather-covered box for camels, ponies, bullocks or mules Yangi Shahr, Chinese town Yuz Bashi, head of 100
