

Bārmáur, $32^{\circ} 26'$; $76^{\circ} 30'$; 7,015 ft., on the left bank of the Budhíl river.

Route No. 15.

From BARAHÁT (Gárvál) to BHÉTI (Gárvál).

A secondary route, passable for horses, but with difficulty.

Barahát, $30^{\circ} 43'$; $78^{\circ} 26'$, on the right bank of the Bhagiráthi river—Sáiri— Δ Panól ka bátel—Cross the Gaséna river—Cross several ridges.

Phatéra—Tsákiát—Phátkót—Cross the Hátalu ka danda pass—*Kumarkótí*—Shim—Kómot—Táte—Cross the Tsólpur river—*Bági*—Cross the Aéra ka danda pass—Méd— Δ Tsákal.

Márriat—Cross the Máddial ka danda pass—Néval—Ágar—Bígun—Dólli—Khót—Cross the Gánal ka danda pass—*Guphál*—Cross the Bálki nádi—Shoála—Guniáli—Ársha—Tansáni— Δ Tíkar—Cross the Píku ka danda pass—Kária.

Bhéti, $30^{\circ} 36'$; $78^{\circ} 44'$.

Route No. 16.

From BARAHÁT (Gárvál) to KUTNÓR (Gárvál).

A principal route, passable for horses.

Barahát, $30^{\circ} 43'$; $78^{\circ} 26'$, on the right bank of the Bhagiráthi river—Bókeri—Phátára—Básung—Badét—Cross the Kakót ka danda pass—Cross the Barána náddi—Káuva—Parár.

Uperkótí—Cross the Rishár nálah—Cross the Monerár pass—Cross the Tsákoni pass.

Shálna.

Kutnór, $30^{\circ} 51'$; $78^{\circ} 19'$; 5,106 ft., a very easy stage.

Route No. 17.

From BARAHÁT (Gárvál) to RÁITAL (Gárvál).

A secondary route, frequently taken by fakirs, impassable for horses.

Barahát, $30^{\circ} 43'$; $78^{\circ} 26'$, on the right bank of the Bhagiráthi river—Jákola—Cross two small nálahs—*Gusáli*—Doár—Notárna.

Ráital, $30^{\circ} 49'$; $78^{\circ} 34'$; 6,949 ft., near the right bank of the Bhagiráthi river.
