from BÉKHAR to NÍSANG,

see **No. 154.****Route No. 22.**From BÉKHAR (Gnári Khórsum) to SHÍPKI
(Gnári Khórsum).

A secondary route, passable for horses.

Maps: Cunningham's Pānjāb and Western Himālaya.—
Gerard's Koonawur.Three marches, always along the left side of the
Sátlej valley. Road described as good; no vil-
lages, except Kiók, which is close to Shíпки.
As yet I know of no European who has made
this route.

From BHÉTI (Gārhwál) to RÁITAL (Gārhwál).

A secondary route, chiefly used by fakirs, im-
passable for horses.*Maps:* Indian Atlas, sheets 65 and 66.*Bhétí*, 30° 36'; 78° 44'—Kária—Cross the Píku ka
dándapass—△Tíkar—Tansáni—Ársha—Guniáli
—Shoála—Cross the Báiki nádi—*Guphál*—Cross
the Balgánga river by bridge—Katúr, on the
right bank of the Balgánga river.*Agúnda*—Cross a river—Kóti—Cross a nálah
—Cross another nálah—△*Bhingár*—△Pan-
grána.

△*Kákra Kárik*—Cross several rivers—△
dharamsála.*Sálu—Súra*—Cross the Bhagiráthi river—
Bandráni.*Ráital*, 30° 49'; 78° 34'; 6,949 ft., near the

From BHÉTI (Gārhwál) to TRÍJUGI NARÁIN (Gārhwál).

A secondary route, passable for horses.

Maps: Indian Atlas, sheets 65 and 66.*Bhétí*, 30° 36'; 78° 44'—Kanarsáur—Cross the
Káni ghāt nálah—△Málláki—Bamóra—*Háth-
kúni*, a dharamsála—Cross the Bhágát river—
△Gúpet—Tsentúli—Cross the Shong ka dándá
ridge—Cross the Lumgáū nálah—Lumgáū.*Sáagri*—Cross the Katadhiát river—Maléta—
Uéna—Cross the Boára ka dándá ridge—Theás—
Chatiáur—Chogiáur—Panéli—Tságar—Ankiáur
—Phat—Baránta—Cross a river by bridge—
Dálang—Cross a river—Mídu—Shídar—Cross
two rivers—Bágeál—Kaibági—Cross a river.△*Buáli kánta ka Mádá*—Cross three
ridges.*Mángu*, a small dharamsála (10,599 ft.) on the
Mángu pass—△*Kándétu* (8,942 ft.).*Tríjugi Naráin*, 30° 41'; 78° 56'; 7,217 ft.**Route No. 25.**

From BHÍMBAR (Pānjāb) to NAUSHÉRA (Rajáuri).

A principal route, passable for horses.
