Route No. 205.

From SRINĀGAR (Kashmīr) to RAULPĪNDI (Pāniāb).
A principal route, passable for horses. Road partly
made and generally good.

Srināgar, 34° 4'.6; 74° 48'.5 \mp ; 5,146 ft., on
the Jhīlum river, the capital of Kashmīr. As
far as

Baramūla the best and easiest way is by
going by boat down the Jhīlum, and passing
through the Vūllar lake — Cross the Jhīlum
river — Continue along the left bank of the
Jhīlum river — Shēri — Kichihāma — Gantamūla.

Naushēra, an easy stage from Baramūla —
Cross the Jhīlum river by a ferry — Līmbur —
Cross a river by a bridge — Tetamūlla — *Kāichena* —
Cross a river — Nūrka — Cross the Nīla Nag
river by a bridge — Gīngal — Doār — Purāna Ūri.

Górigārkh, a fort on the right bank of the
Jhīlum river, opposite Ūri — Continue as far as
Mozāfarabād along the right side of the Jhīlum
valley — Dāchi — Sultān Dāki — Cross a river —
Shādera — Cross a river — Talācha — Steep
descent — Cross the Léven river — Rīkund — Pāla
— Méra.

Kathái, rather a long march — Cross the Kār-
thāma river by a bridge — Būra.

Buliāssa, 7 miles from Kathái (an easy march)
— Cross a large river by a bridge — Denāia —
Naugrá — Chirói — Kāndo — *Nadól* — Adamshāhar
— Kākarvāra — Naushēra — Nēra — Dobāta — Cross
a river.

Hathián, on the right bank of the Jhīlum
river (level of the river 2,529 ft.) — Continue

along the right bank of the Jhīlum river —
Tutatéri — Balotár — *Lāngarpur* (2,266 ft.).

Mozafarabād (2,221 ft.), 14 miles from
Hathián — Cross the Kishangānga river by a
bridge (level of the river 2,164 ft.) — Cross the
Dūp pass (4,491 ft.).

Gārhi Havibūlla (2,678 ft.), with a small bān-
galo, on the right bank of the Nainsūk river;
the village is situated on its left bank (an easy
march) — Continue for two miles along the right
bank of the Nainsūk river — *Ūtar Lāsa* (3,633 ft.;
road very good, but very winding).

Mansēra, 15 miles from Gārhi Havibūlla —
Māngul (4,024 ft.).

Abbotabād (4,055 ft.) — *Chām̄ba* (2,197 ft.), on
the left bank of the Dōr river.

Hāripur, 20 miles from Abbotabād (road very
good, and continues almost level to Raulpīndi)
— *Kōt*.

Usmán Kátir — Join the Peshāur road —
Chāni ke Sang.

A secondary route, passable for horses.
