

- Mubárapur, in the Pānjáb, Lat. 29°, Long. 72° مبارک پور Arab. Hind.
 “*Mubárapur’s town.*” Mubárapur, *blessed*, a personal name. The same name in Audh, Lat. 26°, Long. 82°. See also: Barrackpúr.
- Muftigānj, in Hindostán, Lat. 25°, Long. 82° مفتي گنج Arab. Hind.
 “*Múfti’s market.*” Múfti, *wise*, and also *head law officer*.
- Muktináth, a mountain in Nepál, Lat. 28°, Long. 83° مکتي ناتھ Hind.
 “*Lord of the redemption, or the redeeming Lord.*” Múkti, *redemption*; nath, *lord*; it is frequently used as a personal name.
- Multán, in the Pānjáb, Lat. 30°, Long. 71° مولتان Hind.
 From Mulasthání, a name of the goddess Parvāti. Lassen, Vol. III., p. 645.
- Muradabád, in Hindostán, Lat. 26°, Long. 80° مراد آباد Arab. Pers.
 “*Murád’s town.*” Murád, *desired*, a personal name.
 The same name in Hindostán, Lat. 28°, Long. 78°.
 Anal. Murad-nágar, in Hindostán, Lat. 28°, Long. 77°; Murad-i-kót, in the Pānjáb, Lat. 28°, Long. 70°.
- Murid-ka-kót, in the Pānjáb, Lat. 28°, Long. 70° مرید کا کوت Arab. Hind.
 “*Scholar’s castle.*” Muríd, *a devoted scholar, a follower*.
- Murshidabád, in Bengál, Lat. 24°, Long. 88° مرشد آباد Arab. Pers.
 “*Múrshid’s town.*” Múrshid, *guide, spiritual teacher*.
- Mustafabád, in Sērhínd, Lat. 30°, Long. 77° مصطفى آباد Arab. Pers.
 “*Mústafa’s town.*” Mústafa, *chosen, selected*, frequently used as a personal name.
 The same name in Audh, Lat. 25°, Long. 81°.
- Mustágh, a part of the Karakorúm chain Turk.
 “*Ice mountain, glacier mountain.*” Also used in Bálti. (Not snow mountain.)
 Anal. Aktágh, *white mountain*, a halting place on the road to Yárkand, Lat. 35°, Long. 77°.

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- Nābigānj, in Hindostán, Lat. 27°, Long. 79° نبی گنج Arab. Hind.
 “*Prophet’s town.*”
 Anal. Nābi-púr, in Audh, Lat. 26°, Long. 79°; Nābi-nágar, in Bahár, Lat. 24°, Long. 84°.
- Nādipára, in the Gárro hills, Lat. 25°, Long. 90° ندی پارا Hind.
 “*River village.*”
