between Leh and Yarkand, the other route by the course of the Shayok river, one of the most rapid streams in Tibet, being passable only in winter when the exhaustion and exposure to the cold. We encamped for two days on this pass, and during our short stay ascended (end of August 1856) a peak rising on the left of 20,120 Engl. feet.
