

- C. 127-128. 002.** Chalcedony blade, black; bulb on plain face, the other with central rib. See R. A. Smith in *Man*, xi. 6. No. 52. Length  $1\frac{9}{10}$ ". Pl. XXX.
- C. 127-128. 003.** Jasper blade, black; bulb on plain face, the other with double central rib; one edge worked. See R. A. Smith in *Man*, xi. 6. No. 52. Length  $2\frac{1}{2}$ ". Pl. XXX.
- C. 127-128. 004.** Serpentine (Bowenite) bead, milky, translucent; round perforation and pointed oval section; surfaces smoothed. Length  $\frac{4}{8}$ ".
- C. 127-128. 005.** Ball of wood (?) with projecting point; decaying. Diam.  $\frac{5}{8}$ ".
- C. 127-128. 006.** Snail-shells (?) from C. 127.
- C. 128. 001.** (S.W. of.) Fr. of bronze spear-point; long leaf-shaped blade with solid tang and central rib. Found i. i. 07.  $2\frac{1}{2}$ "  $\times$   $\frac{3}{4}$ "  $\times$   $\frac{3}{16}$ " to  $\frac{1}{16}$ ".
